# Post-Construction Compliance Form For solar projects on contaminated sites and landfills

## **Introduction**

In accordance with the Board of Public Utilities ("BPU") rules for the Competitive Solar Incentive ("CSI") Program (N.J.A.C. 14:8-11.5) and the Community Solar Energy Program ("CSEP") (N.J.A.C. 14:8-9.5), following construction of a solar electric facility located on a contaminated site or landfill or mining site, the applicant must demonstrate compliance with all permits required by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ("NJDEP") for the construction and/or operation of the solar facility, as applicable. The decision of the BPU to issue a final approval in the CSI Program or CSEP is based on the NJDEP's and the applicant's certification and accompanying documentation.

The information and documents described below must be submitted by an authorized representative of the property owner AND an authorized representative of the developer of the solar electric power generation facility. The certification must identify that the applicant has received all relevant permits and is in compliance with all site remediation or site closure and post-closure maintenance requirements as provided by NJDEP.

## Requirements for Certification of Compliance

The certification must include signed and dated original certifications. Photocopies will not be accepted.

The persons responsible for certifying information to BPU shall ensure that the certifications required are signed as follows:

- (a) For a corporation or a limited liability corporation, a principal executive officer that is lawfully authorized to act on behalf of the corporation;
- (b) For a partnership or sole proprietorship, a general partner or proprietor, that is lawfully authorized to act on behalf of the partnership or sole proprietorship;
- (c) For a municipality, State, Federal or other public agency, a principal executive officer or ranking elected official that is lawfully authorized to act on behalf of the municipality, State, Federal or other public agency.

A person is deemed to be a duly authorized representative only if:

- (a) The authorization is made in writing by a person described in (b) above;
- (b) The authorization specifies either an individual or a position having a responsibility for the overall operation of the site or activity, such as the position of plant manager, or a superintendent or person of equivalent responsibility (a duly authorized representative may be either a named individual or an individual identifiable by virtue of a title or position within the organization);
- (c) Documentation identifying the authorization is provided to BPU along with the certification; and
- (d) A statement identifying that in the event an authorization or certifying signature is no longer valid due to a change in authorization or individual or position, a new authorization satisfying the requirements of this section shall be submitted to BPU along with any reports, information, or applications required to be signed by an authorized representative.
